**Consultation on Change of Age Range of East Anstey Primary School**

**Proposal**

Consultation on the change of age range from 4-11 years to 2-11 years with effect from September 2018

---

**Background**

The proposal is for East Anstey Governor-run Pre-School to become part of East Anstey Primary School rather than operating as an extended service. The Pre-School will become a Nursery Class within the school.

Parents will still need to make a separate application to Devon County Council for a place in the Reception class.

**Capital and Impact on the School**

No capital funding will be required by the School from Devon County Council. The increase will not affect the net capacity of the school, nor the Planned Admission Number and will not put pressure on existing classroom space.

**The Process**

In accordance with Department for Education guidance, a change to the age range of one year or more for a Community School requires a statutory consultative process to be undertaken. All responses to this consultation will be carefully considered by the school and Devon County Council, as the decision-maker, and the indicative timetable is as follows:

Consultation: Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> June to Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2018

Brief Notice formal consultation period: June/July 2018 (4 weeks)

Proposed Implementation: September 2018
