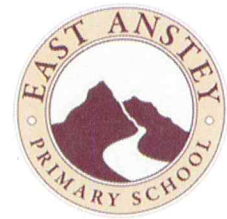
Many thanks for the donations of cakes for our sale — we had a lovely selection. We will count up the donations and report back shortly on how much we raised.
